AURCO Paper Judging Guidelines - For Judges

- 1. Each paper and presentation is judged by at least 2 judges.
- 2. Paper presentations are scheduled in blocks corresponding to AURCO's schedule. (Students should be reminded that the judging is based on the presentation and paper and any additional props or materials should not be used in their presentation.)
- 3. Attempts should be made to question students to see if they are all knowledgeable about topic.
- 4. Following the judging of all papers and presentations the judges will tally the rubrics and use this to help with the determination of winners.

AURCO Paper Guidelines – For Students

- 1. Students will be asked to provide a 5-minute presentation that summarizes their paper. Following the presentation students should be prepared to answer questions from the judges and audience for 5 additional minutes.
- 2. The papers and presentations will be judged on the quality of the paper, quality of the presentation, and the quality of the research performed.
- 3. Additional props or materials should not be used in the presentation.
- 4. First, Second, and/or Third place cash/check prizes are awarded depending on the number of participants.
- 5. The check to the winning papers will be written out to the student whose name was provided on the paper entry form.

Hosting Campus Check List

- 1. Provide time in the program to accommodate student presentations.
- 2. Provide Certificates of Participation for each student.
- 3. Provide copies of grading rubric for judges.
- 4. Provide time during the lunch agenda to announce winners.

AURCO Check List

- 1. AURCO will provide judges for the student competitions.
- 2. AURCO judges will request papers from website manager prior to the conference for scoring.
- 3. AURCO will provide plaques and cash prizes (checks) for the winners.
